## REFLECTION

# REFLECTION FOR 3RD SUNDAY OF LENT (B)

The Temple was the holiest place for Jews. It was the centre of their lives. Jews believe it was built on the actual <u>site that the world was created</u>, the place where Abraham tried to sacrifice Isaac his son (Mount Moriah, 2Chron 3: 1). It is also called Mount Zion. (Is 60: 14; Ps 125: 1) Micah 4: 1 calls it 'The Mount of the house of the Lord.'

It was a sign of the presence of God in their midst. While the Jews were still wandering in the desert, they had moveable places of worship. (Ex 25: 8-9) The first permanent place of worship (Temple) was built in Jerusalem by king Solomon. (2Sam 7: 12-13; 2Chron 2-5) Solomon's Temple was destroyed by the Babylonians. (2 Kgs 25: 8-9; Jer 52: 12-13; 2Chron 36). The Temple was rebuilt by King Herod and it took 46 years. (Jn 2: 20) This second Temple was destroyed by the Roman General, Titus in 70 AD. Jesus predicted the destruction of the Temple in Jn 2:19 and Jerusalem in Mk 14:58; 15:29 and Acts 6:14. All that remained of this Temple is the Western wall also called the Wailing wall. Many Jews believe that touching the ancient stones on the mount connects them to Abraham, David, and most importantly, the presence of God.

By cleansing the Temple, Jesus was also drawing attention away from a physical building to the body as the dwelling place of God. He told the woman at the well, "A time is coming and has now come when true worshippers will worship the Father in the spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshippers the Farther seeks..." (Jn 4: 23-24) (About forty years after Jesus cleansed the Temple, it was destroyed by the Romans. A mosque (Al-Aqsa Mosque) now stands on the site of the second Temple.)

By becoming human Jesus raised the dignity of the human person. We are no longer just creatures of God, but also brothers and sisters of the Son of God. Because we have received the spirit of adoption, we can make bold to call God, "Aba, Father." (Rom 8: 15) Because we have the spirit of God in us, God lives in us. We are also Temples of God. St Paul alluded to this when he said, "For we are the temples of the livin

g God." (1Cor 6: 16) And "Do you not know that your bodies are the temples of the Holy Spirit, whom you received from God? ... Therefore, honour God with your bodies." (1Cor 6: 19-20)

By cleansing the temple, Jesus was teaching us to love and hallow the house of God as he did. We need to follow his example by recognising, revering, and protecting the sacredness of the temple of the church and our own bodies. God dwells in these two temples but even more in our bodies.
