REFLECTION Sixth Sunday of Easter (B) 2024

We are gradually approaching the end of the season of Easter. Thursday this week, we shall celebrate the solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus into heaven. Then on Pentecost Sunday (May 19) we shall celebrate the fulfilment of the promise of Jesus to his disciples, the descent of the Holy Spirit on the apostles, the birthday of the Church. In the gospel of today Jesus talked to his disciples about love. He told them that he loved them as the Father loved him and asked them to remain in his love. Having received his love, he commanded them to "love one another." (Jn 15: 17)

What is love? St John answers the question in 1John 4: 8, "God is love." He went on, "All who live in love live in God, and God lives in them." St Paul tells us in 1Cor 13: 13, "There are three things that last, faith, hope, and love; but the greatest is love." Albert Einstein in a letter to his daughter said, "Love is power, because it multiplies the best we have, and allows humanity not to be extinguished in their blind selfishness." Mahatma Gandhi said, "Love is the strongest force the world possesses, yet it is the humblest imaginable." Martin Luther King Jr said, "Love is the most powerful force in the universe." Mother Teresa said, "True love is love that causes us pain, that hurts, and yet brings us joy." Pope John Paul 11 said, "Love causes man to find fulfilment through the sincere gift of self." Pope Francis said, "God is love. Only through loving can we reach love." Pope Benedict said of love, "What the world needs is God's love; it needs to encounter Christ and to believe in him." Shortly before he died, Pope Benedict XV1 uttered his last words in Italian. He said, "Love, I love you!"

Jesus told us in the gospel, "This is my commandment, love one another as I have loved you." How has Jesus loved us? He has loved us, completely, truly, selflessly, and sacrificially. It is love that makes us children of God. It is love that distinguishes us from those who do not know Jesus. It is love that propels us to reach out and lift us. As St Paul says in 2Cor 5: 14, "For the love of Christ urges us on.

"Yes, love is the most powerful force in the universe. "Many waters cannot quench love, neither can floods drown it," (Song of Solomon 8: 7) because love is God.

As Christians, disciples of Jesus, we must practice love; live in love, and show love. "Love is patient and kind. Love is not boastful or arrogant. Love does not fail." (1Cor 13: 1ff). Love one another!
