REFLECTION for Twenty-Third Sunday (B)

Today the Church celebrates the birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary, mother of our Lord Jesus Christ. Though the earth did not know her at her birth, heaven knew her. Heaven knew she was chosen before her conception to be the mother of the Son of God.

Heaven must have rejoiced exceedingly on the day the Blessed Virgin Mary was born. It was the beginning of the fulfilment of the promise of God to send us a redeemer; it was the beginning of the restoration of the broken link between heaven and earth. It was the beginning of the end of the reign of Satan on earth. The darkness which covered the entire world started receding as the eternal light was coming into the world.

The celebration of Mary's birth started in Syria or Palestine in the 6th century and began in Rome about a hundred years later. The actual date or place are not known. But it does not matter. What matters to us is that the Blessed Virgin Mary was born into the world, and whatever day it was, we celebrate her birth. What we are thanking God for is her birth and not the day. It could be any day, but it could not be any person.

Reflecting on the birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary, St Alphonsus de Liguori wrote, "Having been destined to become the mother of the Eternal Word, this child was enshrined with so great a grace that even at the moment of her Immaculate Conception she exceeded all the saints and angels in sanctity, for she was given a higher order of grace, which corresponds to her dignity of mother of God." She was born a great saint! Mary's soul was the most beautiful soul that God ever created.' It was the most perfect of all God's creatures and creation. Not only her soul, but Mary is also the most beautiful, the most blessed, the most perfect, the most noble, the most 'graced', (full of grace) the most loving and the most lovable, the most excellent of all God's creatures.

Alphonsus de Liguori continued, 'How delightful a sight to heaven and earth must have been the beautiful soul of this happy child! Let us rejoice with our beloved mother Mary who was born so holy, so pure, so beautiful, so loving, so lovable, so clear to God, and so full of grace! Next to the infant Jesus, Mary is the most beautiful and the loveliest child ever born on earth.

What birthday gift do you have for Mother Mary today? The rosary! Offer her the rosary. Say one for Mother Mary today. And if you can, say the 20 decades for her today. It's her birthday. Nothing is too much for a mother who loves us and cares so much for us.

Don't ask her for anything today, it is ours to give her. But don't worry, whether you ask her or not, Mother Mary is a mother who knows our hearts and needs. She is always ready and willing to take our prayers and intentions to her Son; and Jesus does not say no to her.

Happy birthday dearest mother. Accept the thanks, praises, and prayers of your dear children here on earth. May Your Son our Lord Jesus Christ be gloried and praised in you and through you. Amen.
